




Accessing Configuration in CDP Server

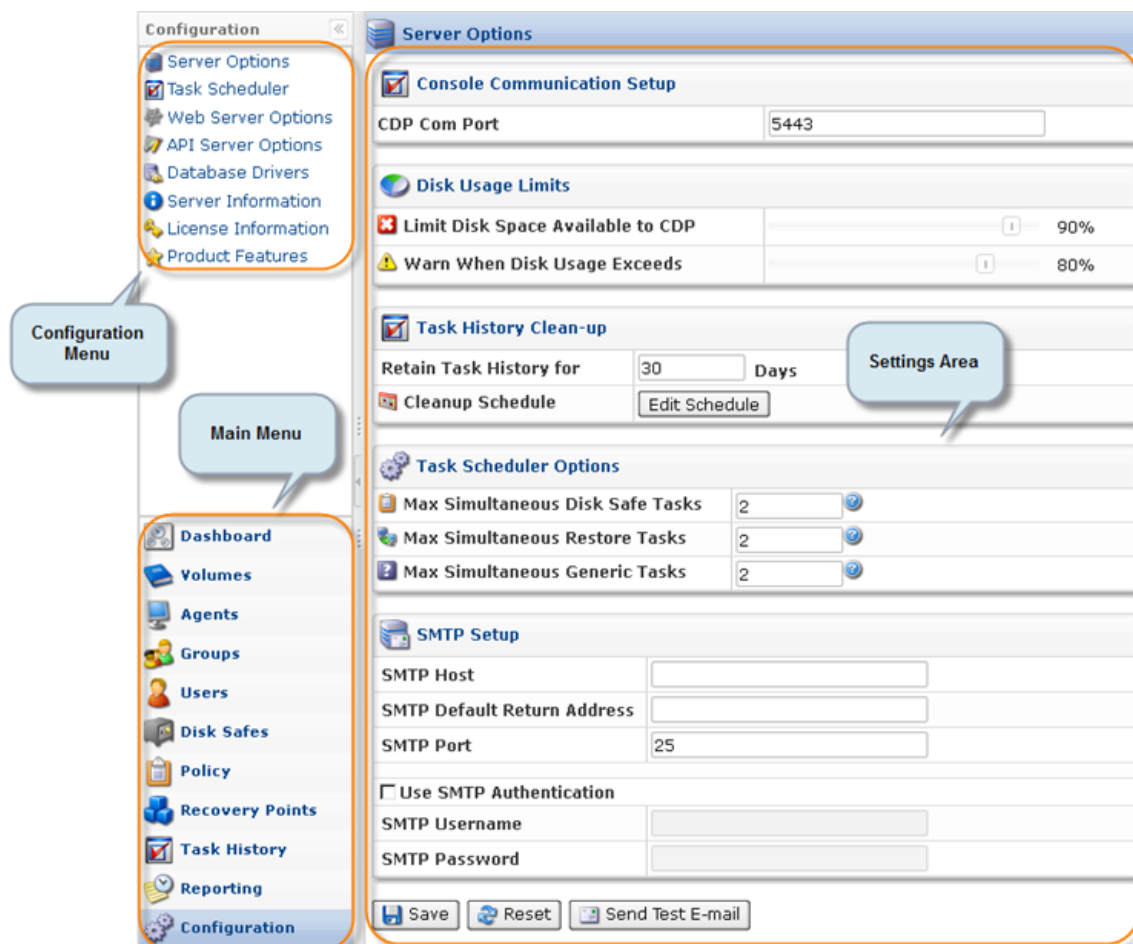
Tip

Example: <http://10.61.200.31/Configuration/>. Note that the address is case sensitive.
